Europass is an Initiative supported by the European Commission to boost employability and mobility in Europe.

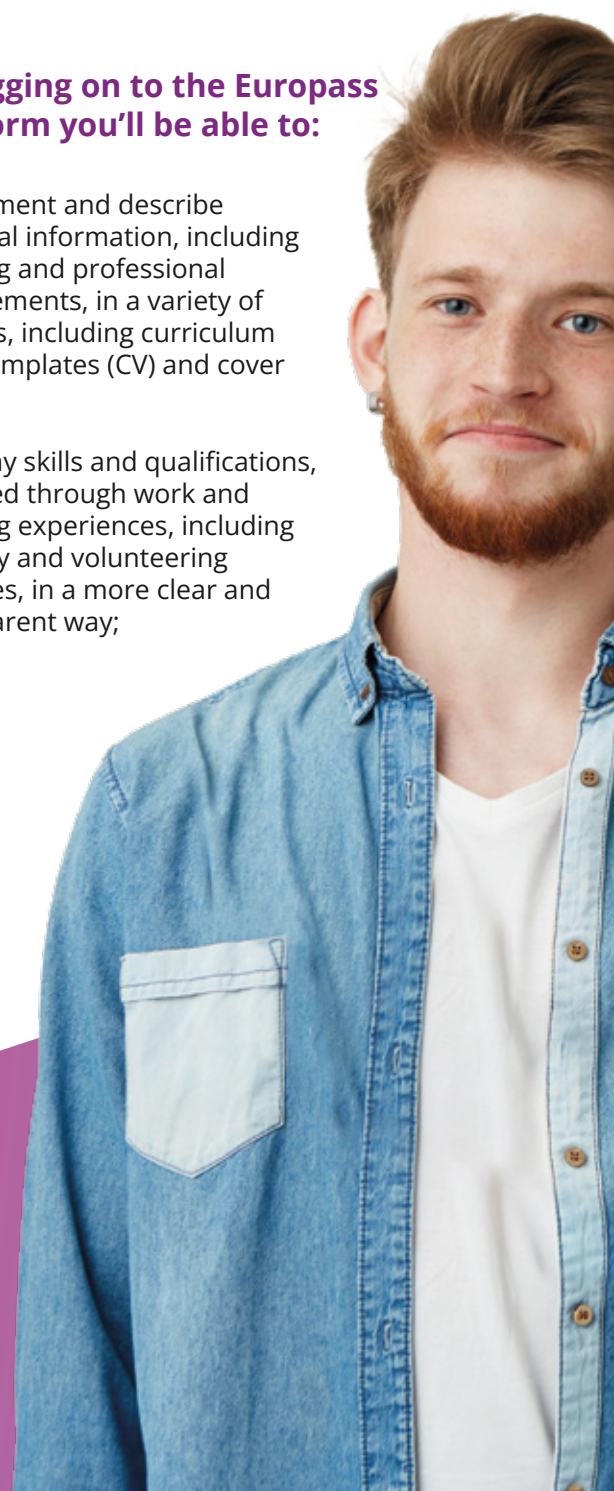
It's presented in a digital platform which provides you with a unique set of digital tools to help you better present, communicate and compare your skills and qualifications throughout Europe.

- Share information for academic or recruitment purposes, through a single link or a PDF file;
- Reflect on your experiences and skills and develop those you don't possess for career or academic planning purposes;
- Receive personalized suggestions on employment, training and learning opportunities.
